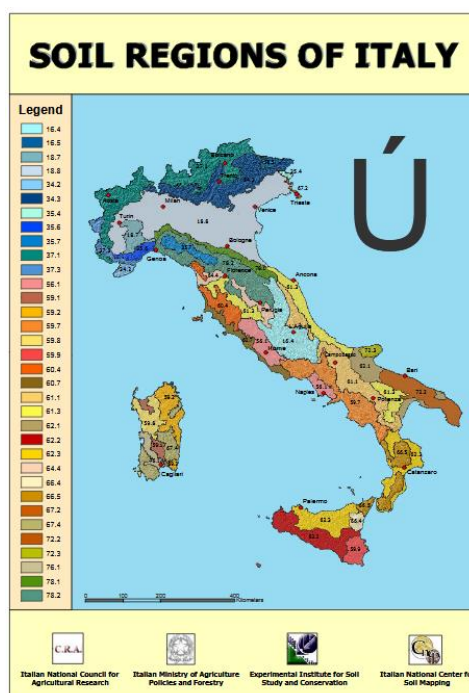

The soil region data base, scaled 1:5,000,000, is an informative soil map of Italy. Soil regions are characterized by a typical climate and parent material association. It also includes a description of the main soil degradation processes, according to their occurrence in the different soil regions. The soil regions database are matched with the Corine land cover and the soil national database, which is maintained by the Italian National Center for Soil Mapping, part of the Experimental Institute for Soil Study and Conservation, to appreciate specific soil characteristics.
